**OUR GOD IS GREAT AND MARVELOUS**  
**LET US MARVEL AT HIS GREATEST WORK OF ALL**

II Corinthians 4:3 But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost:

II Corinthians 4:4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

II Corinthians 4:5 For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus' sake.

**II Corinthians 4:6 For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.**

There is nothing greater and more Marvelous than the work of salvation that God does in the life of His children. This work is a greater work than creation itself. It is as supernatural as when He created Adam and Eve...

Consider it:

It is just as great a miracle as when God said, let there be light and there was light. God spoke and there was light.

Genesis 1:3 And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.

Genesis 1:4 And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness.

Genesis 1:5 And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.

THIS WAS THE FIRST THING THAT GOD DID IN CREATION.

THIS IS NOW THE FIRST THING THAT HE DOES IN THE NEW CREATION.

II Corinthians 4:6 For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

**I. HE COMMANDED THE LIGHT TO SHINE OUT OF DARKNESS.  
WE WHO WERE DEAD IN DARKNESS OF SIN HAVE BEEN TRANSLATED INTO  
THE KINGDOM OF LIGHT.**

What kind of darkness were we in?

II Corinthians 4:3 But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost:

II Corinthians 4:4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

We were in darkness of sin blinded by the enemy.

We were duped by Satan.

He blinded our minds and hearts.

And so it is that people who are not saved are in darkness.  
They are blind.

Only God can give them light.

II Corinthians 4:6 For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

***II. WHEN HE SAID LET THERE BE LIGHT IN OUR HEARTS HE SHINED IN OUR HEARTS THE LIGHT OF THE KNOWLEDGE OF GOD.***

Suddenly we can understand the gospel. Before we were blinded to it!

The light of the knowledge:

I Corinthians 2:11 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.

I Corinthians 2:12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.

I Corinthians 2:13 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

I Corinthians 2:14 But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

I Corinthians 2:15 But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man.

I Corinthians 2:16 For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.

We have the mind of Christ.

God opens the scripture to our minds.

THINK ABOUT IT. This is a greater miracle than opening the eyes of the Blind.

This is the greatest of all miracles. We who were blind can now see.

***III. Is there anything more Marvelous than the work of Salvation that God does in a person's life when they are saved?***

Ephesians 2:1 And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins;

Ephesians 2:2 Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:

Ephesians 2:3 Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.

There is a resurrection of life in our hearts. How can this be explained?

This is a miracle of God.

II Corinthians 4:6 For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

This is a marvelous miraculous work of God the creator of all things.

THINK ABOUT IT.

HOW DEAD IS DEAD? THAT IS HOW DEAD WE WERE BEFORE WE RECEIVED CHRIST AND OUR EYES WERE OPENED TO THE GOSPEL!

What greater work.

What more marvelous act is there? THIS IS THE SONG OF MOSES.  
GREAT VICTORY OVER THE ENEMY.

Revelation 15:3 And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, thou King of saints.

Ephesians 4:8 Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men.

He led us who were captive of Satan captive to Himself.  
He marched us out. He is our Passover lamb!

The song of Moses was a song of victory over Pharaoh's armies. In Exodus 15 we read about the Marvelous victory over Pharaoh's armies. These armies were a type of the armies of the Anti Christ in the tribulation. The song of Moses is a song of victory over God's enemies and in that way, they, Rev. 15:3 the saints in heaven will sing the same song. It will be a song of victory over the enemies of God.

Exodus 15:1 Then sang Moses and the children of Israel this song unto the LORD, and spake, saying, I will sing unto the LORD, for he hath triumphed gloriously: the horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea.

EXODUS 15:2 The LORD is my strength and song, and he is become my salvation: he is my God, and I will prepare him an habitation; my father's God, and I will exalt him.

EXODUS 15:3 The LORD is a man of war: the LORD is his name.

EXODUS 15:4 Pharaoh's chariots and his host hath he cast into the sea: his chosen captains also are drowned in the Red sea.

EXODUS 15:5 The depths have covered them: they sank into the bottom as a stone.

EXODUS 15:6 Thy right hand, O LORD, is become glorious in power: thy right hand, O LORD, hath dashed in pieces the enemy.

EXODUS 15:7 And in the greatness of thine excellency thou hast overthrown them that rose up against thee: thou sentest forth thy wrath, which consumed them as stubble.

EXODUS 15:8 And with the blast of thy nostrils the waters were gathered together, the floods stood upright as an heap, and the depths were congealed in the heart of the sea.

When we are saved, we are redeemed of God and brought out of bandage so we can sing this song of Moses too.
